Dear Parents/Carers,

Arrangements for reporting positive Covid cases to us – 18th – 24th December 2020

I know that yesterday's text messages may have been unsettling for you; it's the first time that we have needed to report 2 cases to you in one day. Please rest assured that we continue to be vigilant in following Covid secure guidance and **always** contact Public Health England (PHE) with comprehensive information before advising you of subsequent actions (bubble closures) and isolation dates. **Thank you to 2M and 3R parents for collecting the children so quickly yesterday after our text. The children were amazing - so courageous, understanding and kind to one another – we are very proud of them and you should be too.**

I am writing to advise of arrangements for reporting positive child Covid cases to us **AFTER** Friday 18th December up until Thursday 24th December 2020.

Contacting us IF your child tests Covid positive.....**need to know up until 24th December**

You already know that, as part of the Government's Test and Trace

and staff) that may have been in close contact with a person who has been confirmed Covid positive; **THIS WILL CONTINUE UP TO AND INCLUDING 24th December 2020 as we may still need to contact families to advise them to isolate if staff or pupils develop symptoms and test positive during the first few days of the holidays.**

Please call us urgently on 07466 871278 to report a pupil (ONLY) positive result from 18th- 24th December ; I may call you back on this number or another mobile number - please accept the call!
