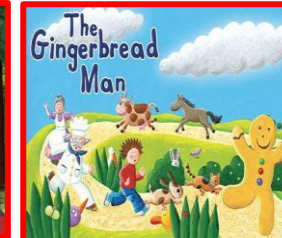
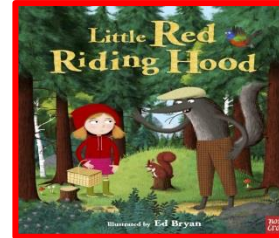
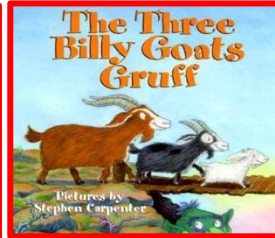
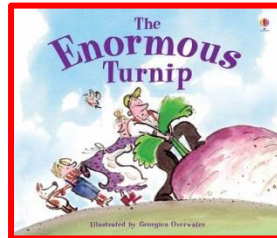
We will learn our new school routines and follow simple instructions. We will be sing lots of nursery rhyme and will listen to lots stories trying hard to respond relevant questions and comments. We will retell traditional tales using story telling vocabulary such as Once upon a time, Next, Fortunately, The end.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

We will be settling in to Reception and begin to build positive relationships with our new adults and friends. Our teachers will support us in playing alongside our friends and sharing. We will learn to go to the toilets and wash our hands independently. We will be learning about our emotions and who can we go to for help.

Physical Development

We will be learning to negotiate space and obstacles safely whilst exploring different ways of moving. In PE we will be learning basic gymnastic actions. We will be learning to hold a pencil effectively through pattern tracing in preparation for writing.

SPECIFIC AREAS

Literacy

In Phonics will be recapping Phase 1 (initial sounds and orally segmenting and blending) and learning our Phase 2 sounds - s a t p i n m d g o c k ck u e r. We will be learning tricky words – is I The. We will begin to read simple words with the support of our teacher. We will be practising name writing and letter formation.

Maths

We will be learning to match and sort objects based on number, colour and shape. We will also be learning to compare amounts, size, mass and capacity. We will be making simple repeated patterns and learning our daily routines. We will be doing lots and lots of counting!

Understanding the World

We will be learning about the origins of stories and the countries they come from. For example, whilst reading the Enormous Turnip we will learn about Russia. We will be learning about people who are special to us and how they help us.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be drawing story maps to help us retell traditional tales. We will also be making masks and puppets to help us act out stories and nursery rhymes. We will be printing with vegetables and drawing portraits of our special people. We will be exploring our role play areas in our classrooms.
