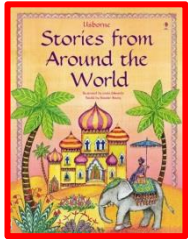


## PRIME AREAS

### Communication & Language

We will begin to offer explanations for why things might happen and make use of recently introduced vocabulary from stories and rhymes. We will start to make comments about what we have heard and ask questions to clarify our understanding. We will continue to retell stories using vocabulary such as Once upon a time, Next, Fortunately and The end.

### Personal, Social, Emotional Development

We will continue to build positive relationships with our adults and friends and take turns in our play. We will begin to show an understanding of our own feelings and those of others. We will explore similarities and differences between ourselves and our friends and learn how to be kind and caring young citizens.

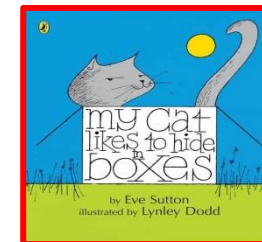
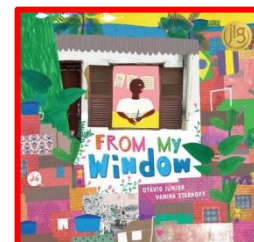
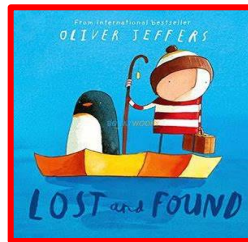
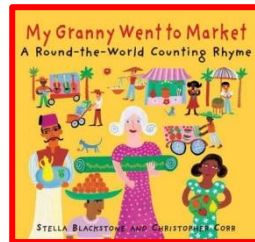
### Physical Development

## SPECIFIC AREAS

### Literacy

In Phonics will be continuing our Phase 2 sounds - h, b, f, l, ff, ll and ss. We will begin our Phase 3 sounds - j, v, w, x, y, sh, th, ng and nk. We will be learning tricky words – put, pull, full, as, and, has, his, her, she, he, of, go, we, me and be. We will begin to read simple words and continue to practise name writing and letter formation

### Maths

We will be introduced to numbers 1 – 5, finding different ways to represent and make these numbers. With support from our teachers we will learn how to use a number line to find 1 more and 1 less than a given number. We will also be 2D shapes by going on a shape hunt around the school.

### Understanding the World

We will be travelling around the world through our stories, learning about Thailand, China, Turkey, Spain and the Antarctic and many more! We will also be learning about where our families are from and celebrate each other's cultures. In science, we will carry out a floating and sinking experiment to test our homemade boats

### Expressive Art and Design

We will be looking at and recreating art from across the globe. We will be using recycled materials to build models and modes of transports. We will continue to make puppets, masks and props to support us in our role play and our retelling of stories.
